The Curriculum

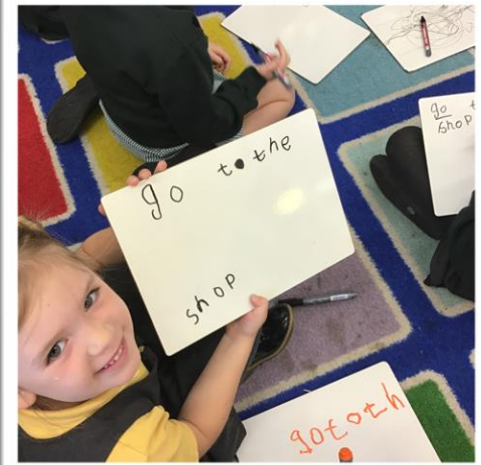
We base our curriculum around themes which always start off with a big question, some of the big questions they will be asking next year are;

- **Is everybody's home the same?**
- **How can we help Cinderella have a ball?**
- **Twinkle, twinkle, little star how I wonder what you are.**
- **Was it once upon a mixed up time?**
- **How do we make sense of the world?**

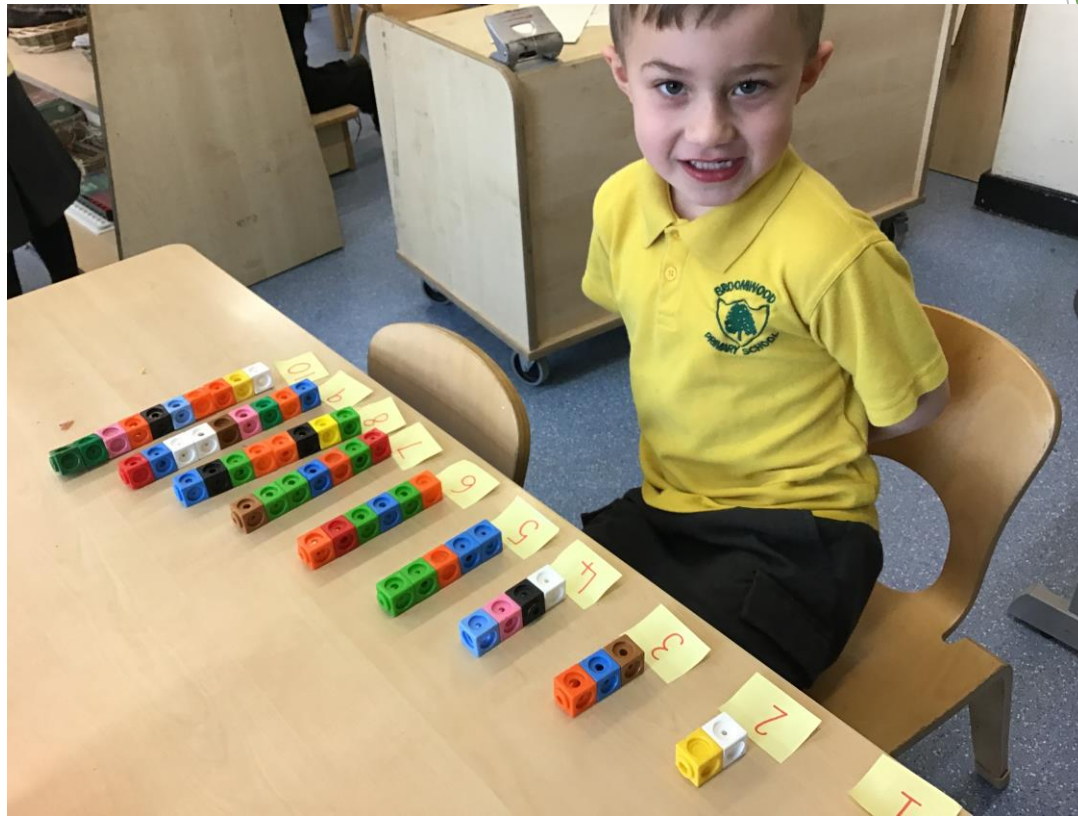
We also take into account children's interests and use these alongside our curriculum. Every Friday we have a 'finding out Friday' where we ask the children what they want to learn about!

A Typical Day in Reception

8:45	Children enter via the main playground
8:55	Literacy carpet session themed around our big question
9:20	Focus groups with the class teacher or teaching assistant/Continuous Provision
11:00	Phonics session (Read Write Inc)
11:20	Lunch
11:45	Outdoor Play
12:30	Start of the afternoon session - whole class carpet session linked to Maths
1:15	Focus groups with the class teacher or teaching assistant/Continuous Provision
2:55	Final carpet session of the day to share learning, stories and songs
3:15	Home time - Children are picked up from the classroom door

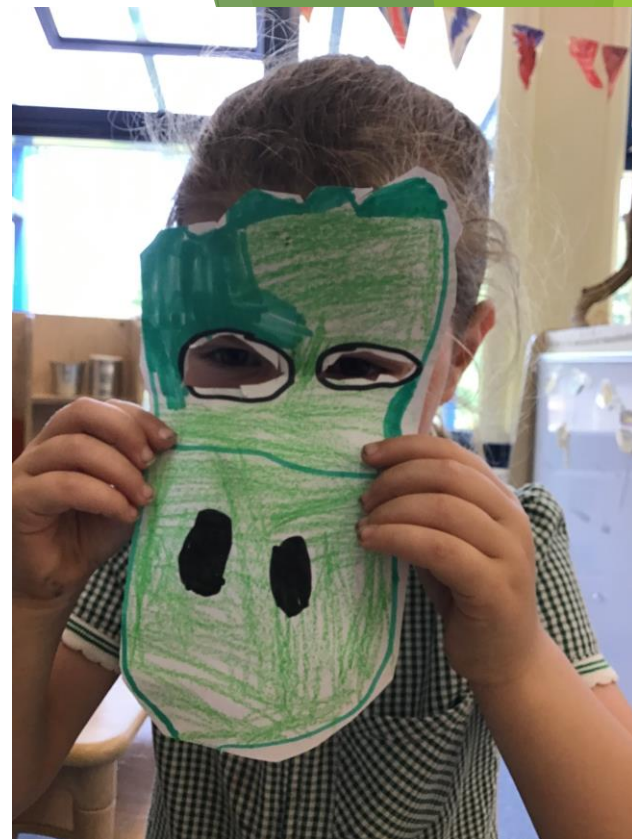

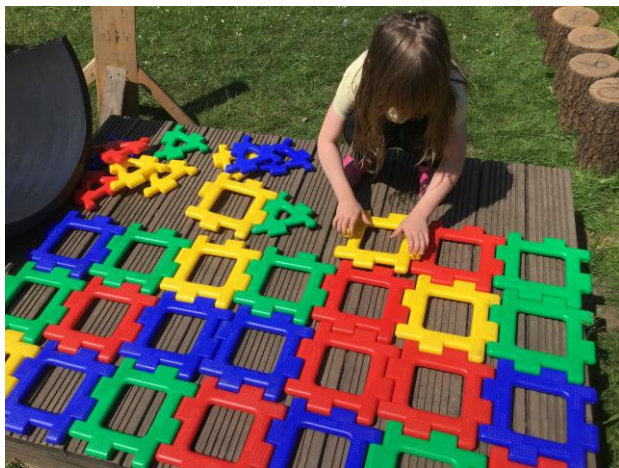
