

## KSI Seasonal Changes - Biology

Subject Specific Vocabulary		Memorable Image	Exciting Books
Season	The four parts of the year - Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter.		
Spring	The season after winter when new vegetation grows - March, April, May.		
Summer	The warmest season of the year (In our hemisphere) - June, July and August.		
Autumn	The season after Summer - September, October and November.		
Winter	The coldest season of the year (in our hemisphere) - December, January and February.	Sticky Knowledge	Scientist
Months	A period of time consisting of approximately 4 weeks or 28-31 days.		
Forecast	To estimate or guess (the weather)		
Weather	The state of the atmosphere regarding heat, cloudiness, dryness, sun, wind and rain.		
Rain Gauge	A device for collecting and measuring the amount of rain that falls.		
Data	Facts and information gathered.		
Shadow	A dark area or shape produced by a body or object coming between sources of light and a surface.		
Thermometer	A tool used to measure the temperature using degrees celcius.		
Evergreen	This is a type of tree that does not shed its leaves in the winter.		
Deciduous	Trees and shrubs that, unlike evergreens, lose their leaves and become dormant during the winter.		
Coniferous	Trees and shrubs that produce cones and have leaves that do not fall off in the winter.		
Temperature	The measure of hotness or coldness expressed on a scale e.g Degrees Celsius.
