Angles	Tribes from modern day Denmark	I can describe what daily life was like for Anglo-Saxons and their children. I know what Anglo-Saxon settlements were like.	
Saxons	German-Dutch tribes who settled in Britain from around 450AD	I know some of the causes of Anglo-Saxon migration	
Jutes	Tribe from modern day Denmark	I know that Anglo-Saxon Paganism involved the worship of many gods.	
Christianity	A religion based on the teaching of Jesus	I know that there were two forms of Christianity over the Anglo-Saxon period (Romans and Celtic)	
Paganism	A religion that involves worshipping many Gods and Goddesses	I can describe the reasons for the spread of Christianity and the decline of Paganism.	
Missionary	A person from a religion sent to spread the faith	I know some of the key events of Alfred's life and reign.	
Picts	Tribes originally from Scotland who were 'foul' and had a 'lust for blood'	I know about some of the significant treasures of the Anglo-Saxons for example, the artefacts found at the Sutton Hoo burial site. Local examples could be: Pelican Pub, Nico-Ditch, Angel Stone.	
Scots	People from Ireland, who like the Picts, were fierce and powerful fighters

Settlement	A place where people live and sometimes work		
Invasion	When a foreign army enters a country, by force		
Archaeologist	A person who studies human history and prehistory through the excavation of sites and the analysis of artefacts and other physical remains.
