



Exchange	An act of giving one thing and receiving another	I know that Christopher Columbus (1451-1506) was an explorer known for his discovery of the New world.	  
Disease	An illness or disease characterised by specific symptoms	I know that Columbus travelled and explored on his ship Santa Maria.	
Voyage	A long journey involving travel by sea	I know that the Old World includes Africa, Asia and Europe.	
Exploration	The action of exploring an unfamiliar area	I know that the New World includes North America, South America and the Caribbean.	
Catholicism	A denomination of Christianity linked to the Roman Catholic Church	I know that the Columbian exchange is the interchange of plants, animals, and disease between the Old and New World.	
Influenza	A highly contagious and viral infection which affects the respiratory system (the flu)	I can identify some crops, food and animals from the Old World including: pigs, chickens, sheep, cows, coffee, sugar cane, onions, bees, pears.	
Native	A person born in a specific place	I can identify some crops, food and animals from the New World such as: corn, beans, squash, tomatoes, peanuts, tobacco and turkey.	
Colony	A country or area under control by another country	I can identify some diseases that were passed from the Old World to the New World for example: Malaria, measles, smallpox, influenza.
