Itinerary

Depart: Monday September 30th

09:00 Assemble in the Y6 classroom in your own clothes. (SUITABLE FOR THE FIRST ACTIVITY) Leave all bags in the hall.

10:00 - 10:15 Pack the bags onto the coach and leave school.

11:45 - 12:00 Arrive at Whitemoor Lakes and have a look around the grounds and eat packed lunch. A text message will be sent to inform parents/carers we have arrived safely. **(Bring your own packed lunch in a disposable bag)**

2:00 First activity begins

Tuesday October 1st

11am Depart Whitemoor Lakes

12.30pm Eat lunch when we are back at school (provided by Whitemoor Lakes)

1pm **ALL** children to be collected from school.

(Approximate time depending on traffic; school will text parents/carers on our return journey to keep them updated)

The children are split into 4 or 5 groups for the activities, however will be together at all other times - breaks, meals etc.

Medical Needs

All medicines are to be given to Miss White prior to the holiday with instructions on and clearly labelled. Please write these on the medical forms and also talk through with Miss White at some point, even the morning of the trip, regarding guidance on administering.

Meals

The children will receive breakfast, lunch and an evening meal during our stay. The children will be required to bring a packed lunch on Wednesday to take with us. **Please inform us of any dietary needs or allergies. Mrs Cannon will be in charge of all dietary needs.**

Mobile Phones

For security reasons, **mobile phones are NOT allowed on the trip.** If there is an emergency we will use our phones to contact home.

Electrical items

For security reasons, **electronic games, iPods/iPads etc are not allowed on the trip.**

Children may bring a camera on the trip; I would recommend a disposal one. School will be taking lots of photographs that parents/carers and children can look at and a selection will be shown during their Leavers' Assembly.

Footwear and clothing

The children need an old pair of boots or trainers for outdoor activities and another pair of shoes, trainers or slippers for wearing indoors. They will also need at least two pairs of trousers for outdoors - not jeans please as these do not dry easily when wet. A full clothing list is enclosed in this brochure.

Old clothes are perfect.

Please note that aerosols are not allowed as they set off the alarms in the rooms - only roll-on deodorants should be used

Pocket Money

You are requested to bring spending money into school on Monday 30th September in your luggage. The children should bring no more than £10 altogether and this should all be in coins .

There are vending machines at Whitemoor Lakes, which **only** take coins. The shop is only open for a limited time and there is nowhere else to get change, **so please send the money in coins - 10p, 20p, 50p and £1.**

The shop is open once for 30 minutes before an evening activity. The vending machines sell sweets, chocolate, crisps, drinks etc.

The shop has a range of items, which you can buy with Whitemoor Lakes' logo on as a memory of your trip, or as a present for someone. There is no necessity to have extra money or purchase anything.

The Bedrooms

Sleeping Arrangements

Broomwood have their own 2 blocks of rooms, which no-one else has access to other than ourselves.

All accommodation is en-suite; the children go to the toilet and shower in their own rooms.

We have spare rooms if needed.

Bedrooms will be allocated a couple of weeks before we go.

Activity clothing (minimum)

- 2 pairs of trainers/sturdy footwear for OUTDOOR use - 1 pair will get wet.
- 1 pair of trainers/ shoes for INDOOR use.
- Old trousers, tracksuits bottoms (min of 3 pairs for outdoor use) JEANS ARE NOT SUITABLE
- T-shirts.
- 2 warm long sleeve tops.
- 2 sweatshirt/hoody.
- 1 waterproof coat or cagoule.
- Warm hat / gloves
- Bin bags
- Toiletries - no aerosols
- Towels - at least 2!
- Night attire.
- Casual clothing to wear around the centre.
- Underwear
- Refillable water bottle

Please bring 2 bin bags to put any wet clothing in and bring plenty of spare clothes!
