Dear Parents and Carers,

Sadly your child's last week at Broomwood is fast approaching. Here is a reminder of the celebrations that we have planned for the last week of term to mark the momentous occasion.

On **Monday 22nd July**, we are performing our show-stopping performance of Shrek. As mentioned in a previous letter, you will need to collect your tickets from the office: a maximum of two tickets are available per family and you can decide to get either one ticket for each of the two shows or two tickets for just one of the shows.

Doors will open at 5.45pm – please come in through the gate on the playground where the children usually arrive in the morning.

Due to the numerous social media issues that have arisen this year within Upper Key Stage Two, the children will not be permitted to bring their phones into school to take photos. If they would like to get some keep sake memories, you are invited to stay at the ball with your child **from 5.45pm until 6pm** to take some photos of them with their friends. Furthermore, you are welcome to take photos during the afternoon tea assembly. On the last day of school, the children can take photos right at the end of the day when they have left their class teachers to be released at home time.
