Dear Parents and Carers,

As a school, we have been invited to join two other schools in helping Chris Walker Plants create a community garden for Tatton Flower show, 19th – 23rd July. It is an annual event organised by the RHS (Royal Horticultural Society) at Tatton Park – an event which gets significant media coverage – and it is a great honour to be a part of it as an exhibitor! As a member of the 'Living off the Land Club', your child is going to play a key role in creating and presenting this garden.

So far, the children have been working with Mrs Walton to make bee homes for the display garden but we would also like them to go and visit Chris Walker Plants Nursery to help with the cultivation of the plants for the garden. These visits will be early on a Tuesday morning to avoid any impact on learning. The plan will be to leave school at 8.45am, walk to the nursery, help with the gardening for half an hour and then return to school for approximately 9.45am. The intention is that the group will go each week with Mrs Powell and Mrs Shelton from Tuesday 20th June until Tuesday 11th July. Our hope is that they will be able to attend the flower show at the end of July to build and then present the garden to the public, I will be in touch with further details about this nearer the time. Tickets for the flower show are very expensive but at the end of the show Chris Walker Plants will transport the garden back to their nursery for everyone to visit for free.
