Our approach to managing behaviour is underpinned by the development of authentic relationships and unconditional positive regard for all.

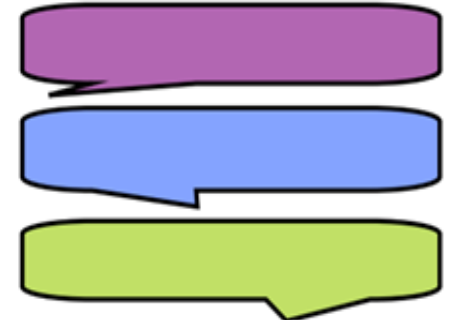
## Relational Belonging Principles

At Broomwood Primary School we implement the following relational belonging principles to support children in managing their behaviour within school.

- Connection before Correction
- Growth over Compliance
- Calm is Contagious
- Share Responsibility
- Relational Repair

## The Zone Board & Rewards

At Broomwood we implement rewards as we believe that children within our school community respond well to this, in addition to regular verbal praise. Children can be moved up through the zone board for demonstrating one of the core values and are rewarded with a sticker on their sticker chart once they get to purple.



A full sticker chart earns them a visit to the Head or Deputy to receive a prize.

Other rewards include marbles in a jar (30 to get a class reward), postcards home and star of the week award.

# Our curriculum

We base our curriculum around themes which always start off with a big question.

Pre- school	Nursery
What makes me, me?	Who lives in my house?
Who are the most amazing animals that appear in my story?	What can you spot through a magnifying glass?
	What do I know about the amazing animals in my book?
Look up, look down, what is all around?	Mary Mary quite contrary, how does your garden grow?
	What can I do with water?

Within these themes we also take into consideration what the children show an interest in and work them into these themes, as well as having a Finding out Friday where we explore those interests further.

8:30am-9:00am	Continuous provision
9:00am-9:15am	Carpet session themed around the big question and current learning
9:15am -11:00am	Continuous provision inside and outside
11:00am- 11:20am	Tidy up/story time
11:20am	Full-time children go to lunch
11:30am	Home time for part-time children
