I am pleased to inform you that the Year Five and Six children are going to be visiting the Imperial War Museum as part of this term's topic: Is it right to fight? The Imperial War Museum explores the conflicts that Britain and the Commonwealth have been involved in since the First World War to the current day through a timeline of objects. During the day, the children will engage in a workshop led by the knowledgeable museum staff. This interactive experience investigates remembrance and personal stories from the First World War to today. Furthermore, we will be exploring the activity trails which are available in the museum, in order to teach the children more about daily life during the war.

When is the Trip taking Place?
